

World Shakespeare Congress 2021: Shakespeare Circuits

Seminar and Workshop Outline

Seminars: There are thirty-four seminars in which delegates can enrol. Seminars span a range of topics from translation and intercultural performance to gender and media. Delegates can join one seminar to present and discuss their research.

Workshops: There are five workshops in which delegates can enrol. The workshops offer opportunities for hands-on experience in working with Shakespeare, such as among specialised communities or engaging with digital tools.

Seminar and Workshop Registration

Seminars and workshops on a wide range of topics related to the overall Congress theme are an important part of the programme. Seminar and workshop leaders will coordinate the facilitation of their sessions and solicit papers or other materials from their participants once enrolment for the seminars and workshops has been confirmed. Enrolment for seminars and workshops will be collated centrally and details of the participants sent to session leaders.

The modes of meeting and working together in the seminars and workshops will be decided by the session leaders, and are likely to include Zoom meetings.

Enrolment is open to all members of the International Shakespeare Association. Delegates may participate in only one of the thirty-nine seminars or workshops listed, and should submit four different choices. Enrolment forms submitted without a range of choices may have to be assigned to a session at the organisers' discretion. Places are filled on a first-received, first-enrolled basis.

Delegates must be current ISA members in order to enrol in seminars or workshops. All seminar and workshop leaders must be members of the ISA and have paid their membership subscription before the conference. The ISA annual membership fee is 20 GBP, and can be paid via the [ISA online payment system](#). Please note that the ISA membership fee is processed separately from the Congress registration.

The closing date for seminar and workshop enrolment has been extended to 1 April 2021.
